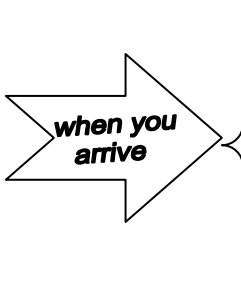




Nuts and Bolts about Registration Day

Registration is in the Cabin Village (follow signs)
on your Sunday from 3:00pm - 4:00 pm
(early arrivals are asked to wait until registration opens)

Lost on your way to camp?

Bring with you into Registration

1. all medications (prescription and non-prescription, we keep ibuprophen and Tylenol on hand)
2. camp store money
3. photo money (\$5 for a photo of your child's camp)
4. prewritten letters you wish to leave for your camper

Leave your stuff in the car until you know where you're going

1. Check in

At check in you will find out who your counselor is and where you will be staying for the week. We will also double check your address and emergency phone numbers.

You may wish to bring letters or notes with you to registration to be delivered throughout the week.

Emails are printed and delivered each day about lunchtime. Be sure to include your camper's name on their fax or e-mail.

2. Have your Money Handy \$\$\$

Deposit money for the camp store The Camp Store does not have food items for sale. It offers souvenir and convenience items. All money deposited is tracked during the week as the camper makes purchases. We suggest \$25-30. All camp store profits go to the Moyer Campership fund which provides financial assistance to campers. Unclaimed balances will be gratefully added to the fund.

Purchase a Camp Photo. A picture of your child's camp will be available for \$5 with advance payment at the time of registration (we only print the number ordered at registration).

3. Meet the Health Care Coordinator

bring all medications
(in original bottles with labels and instructions)

4. Move in!

Now you grab your gear and move in to your cabin, sukkah or head for your campsite, your counselor is there waiting for you! Mom and Dad, this is your opportunity to meet your child's counselor.

(Note: Please try to share information that you want your child's counselor to know on the 'Info for your Counselor' sheet. It is difficult to share information in the midst of Sunday arrivals.)

The Camp Store will be open during registration.

Directions to Camp

From I-81 (**Harrisonburg or Strasburg/I-66**)

From I-81 take **exit #279, Edinburg** and turn east toward town. Cross the railroad tracks and turn left at the stop sign onto Rt. 11 North, proceed about 1/3 mile. At the "Jeep" sign (Edinburg Motors) turn right on Rt. 675, there will be some marker signs for Fort Valley and Camp Roosevelt. Follow Route 675 for approximately 6 miles (up and over the mountain) to the Yield sign at King's Crossing where you turn right, and immediately lean left at the fork in the road (you will see an adopt a highway sign with Caroline Furnace on it). Continue for two (2) miles where you will see a large green Caroline Furnace Lutheran Camp sign on your right -Follow signs to registration.

From Rt. 211 (**Luray**)

When approaching Luray on Rt. 211 from either the east or west, take **Rt. 211 Bypass** to the Rt. 340 Business South exit, at the end of the ramp turn toward Luray. Continue about ¼ mile (beyond the "Welcome to Luray, home of Luray Caverns" sign) to Rt. 675, Mechanic Road turn RIGHT. Ride on Rt. 675 for 3.6 miles (the name of the road changes to Bixler's Ferry Road) where you will cross the Shenandoah River and come to a Yield sign. At the Yield sign turn LEFT, go ½ mile and turn at the first RIGHT (Fort Valley Road). Ride this up and over the mountain for 4.5 miles (you will pass a yellow & brown sign for Camp Roosevelt) and come to an intersection without a stop sign - Follow signs to registration.

- _____ old shoes for creek walking and river wear (sandals or water shoes are also ok)
- _____ Socks that cover ankles
- _____ Practical camp clothing (shorts, jeans, PJs, underwear, socks, tshirts, etc.)
- _____ Warm jacket/sweatshirt (mornings are chilly)
- _____ Rain coat/ poncho
- _____ towels (3-4) for showering and for the lake
- _____ Bible, pen or pencil, journal
- _____ Pillow, Sleeping bag
or sheet/blankets for cabins, small polyester/nylon sleeping bags work best on river

River Trips:

Polyester/nylon dries a lot quicker than cotton. Pack your socks, shirts, shorts and sleeping bags with this in mind. Also, pack long pants and dry shoes for camping on the riverside and shoes that can get wet. Dry bags are provided.

Equipment is provided for trips (i.e. backpacks, canoes, PFDs, dry bags, etc).



Closed toe comfortable fitting shoes are recommended for **all camps**.
